### EXPANDING ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE SPECIALISTS

Methodist Medical Group and Methodist Midlothian recently completed a \$2 million expansion project to open a new specialty clinic in the professional office building next door to the hospital. The clinic is the new home for physicians on the hospital's medical staff who specialize in cardiology, orthopedics, neurosurgery, and more.

Located on the second floor of the building, the space includes patient rooms, a reception area and dedicated offices for physicians and medical assistants. The addition of the clinic allows them to see more patients and gives residents the option of staying in the community for their various healthcare needs.

"We're extremely excited about the continued expansion of services being offered within our professional office building and to see the growth of specialty providers in the region," states **Jary Ganske**, president of Methodist Midlothian. "It's amazing to see the number of physicians that are coming to the office space to care for the community. This allows our patients to receive care closer to home."

Community leaders, hospital staff, and physicians held a ribbon-cutting ceremony and toured the expanded space. The physicians began seeing their first patients in the specialty clinic in late August.



### METHODIST MIDLOTHIAN GROWING INPATIENT CARE CAPABILITIES

Methodist Midlothian recently began a \$20 million expansion to add fifth floor patient suites to meet the growing healthcare needs of the rapidly expanding community in Ellis County.

The construction of the hospital's fifth floor, previously shell space, will now include intermediate care suites for patients and office space. The new facilities are scheduled to open in fall 2024.

"When we opened in 2020, we pledged to the community that we will deliver quality, compassionate healthcare close to where residents live and work. With the continued expansion, we are fulfilling that promise," says **Jary Ganske**, president of Methodist Midlothian.

Methodist Midlothian aligns this expansion with the health system's long-term goal to provide more patients with access to its award-winning care by addressing the medical needs of the growing populations in the areas it serves.

"The need to expand, after less than four years since our opening, demonstrates that we have exceeded the community's expectations. We look forward to enhancing our team and expanding our services," Ganske says.

## METHODIST MIDLOTHIAN WOMEN'S SERVICES EARNS A NEW HOSPITAL DESIGNATION

The Methodist Midlothian Women's Service unit recently received its second designation as a Level I (Well Nursery) Neonatal Facility in Perinatal Care. This designation reflects a facility's capabilities and history of providing care to their patients, and our hospital met all of the requirements set by the Texas Department of State Health Services.

A Level I newborn nursery shows our hospital's capability to stabilize sick or premature babies until they can be safely transferred to a more specialized unit. It signals to families that we have a neonatal nurse practitioner on-site 24/7 to provide a high level of care for our patients.

"We are extremely proud of the unit leadership that pushed us to earn another designation that supports the care of mothers and their babies," says **Jary Ganske**, president of Methodist Midlothian. "This is just another example of our hospital continuing the commitment to quality care for all of our patients."



## A LESSON IN HEART HEALTH

Methodist Midlothian showcased the hospital's new cardiac catheterization lab to participants of the Leadership Midlothian program, which promotes community engagement among residents and business professionals.

Participants got an up-close look at the city's only hospital and learned about the cool technology in our facility.
